## Academic information

### Language requirements for French and English

The exchange program guidelines establish that students must have sufficient knowledge of the French language. To attest the level in French and/or English, students must provide either an official test, a certificate from a language instructor stating the [CECR Level equivalence](#).

✦ For **exchange students**, a B1 level is recommended in French and in English depending if they choose courses in French or in English.

✦ For **double-degree students**, a B1 level is required in French and in English. To obtain the diploma, they will have to obtain a B2 level in French and in English.

### French language courses

Extensive courses : start from October 2025, under request. Mandatory for Double Degree students and some master degrees (*please ask your administrative referent*)

French language courses are free of charge for international students

Transcripts will be send to the student and sending institution after the mobility period (end of February / end of June)

### Information regarding the French Grading System

All academic transcripts issued by our school *Phelma, Grenoble INP – UGA* are based on the French grading system described below.

Grenoble INP – UGA uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

Each course is marked on a scale from 0 to 20.  
0 being the lowest and 20 the highest.

The minimum score to validate a course is 10/20: students obtain ECTS credits when their score reaches a grade greater than 10.

Grading conversion :

### Grading system : [European Credit Transfer System \(ECTS\)](#)

One academic year = 60 ECTS,  
one semester = 30 ECTS

Exchange students take a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester or 60 ECTS per year
